This year's orientation/registration is on Friday, August 7th. There are two different schedules, one for new students, the other for returning students:

New Student Orientation/Registration – 8:30 AM to 2:00 PM for students/8:30 to 10:00 AM for parents/guardians

This extended orientation is designed to help your student get to know the school, teachers, and classmates. As part of the orientation, there is a special component specifically for parents and guardians to learn more about the transition to ACMS and to ask questions of parents and guardians of current ACMS students. There are a number of fun and important activities that happen during orientation, so please make plans to attend!

Returning Student Orientation/Registration – 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM (students and families may come at any point during this two-hour window of time to meet with advisors and complete required paperwork for the 2009-2010 school year)
